Environmental Plan

Energy

An energy management plan is in place for recording, monitoring and reducing the energy consumption. The electrical equipment we purchase or replace and the energy systems (lighting, air conditioning etc) are energy efficient.

Energy consumption is regularly recorded and monitored in kilowatt hours (KWH).

Water

A water management plan is in place - based on water utility bills - for recording, monitoring and reducing water consumption.

Water consumption is regularly recorded and monitored in cubic meters.

Waste

A waste management policy is in place defining how solid waste is reused, recycled and disposed of in compliance with national and international waste regulations.

Food and Beverages

We have adopted the "Greek Breakfast" program and all the first raw materials we use come from local farms and shops and organic establishments.

Training & Involvement

Our staff is continuously trained so that they are aligned with management's objectives and
